## CAMP CLARK WILLIAMSON, INC. FACILITY & GROUNDS USE POLICY

## **Statement of Purpose**

The facilities of Camp Clark Williamson (CCW) are provided through God's benevolence and by the sacrificial generosity of the Churches of Cornerstone and Mid South Presbyteries of the Cumberland Presbyterian Church (CPC). CCW desires that its facilities be used for the fellowship of the Body of Christ and always to God's glory. These facilities are available for use by Cumberland Presbyterians and others, as a witness to our faith, in a spirit of Christian charity, and as a means of demonstrating the Gospel of Jesus Christ in practice.

Use of the facility will be granted to persons or groups whose beliefs and practices are in harmony with the faith and moral teachings of the CPC, as contained in the Holy Scriptures and are summarized in, among other places, the CPC Confession of Faith\* (which is incorporated herein by reference, as if included in its entirety) and the annual proceedings of the CPC General Assembly\*\* (which are incorporated herein by reference, as if included in its entirety). Facilities may not be used for activities that contradict or are deemed by the CCW Board of Trustees to be inconsistent with or contrary to, the CPC's faith or moral teachings. The CCW Board, or their official designee, are the final authority as to the question of a person or group being allowed to use CCW facilities.

## **Approved Users and Priority of Use**

The CCW Board, or their official designee, must approve all uses of CCW facilities. Priority shall generally be given to the Presbyterial camps and retreats and activities, and congregations of the Cumberland Presbyterian Church. CCW facilities and equipment will be made available to non-members or outside groups meeting the following qualifications:

- 1) The group or person seeking facility use must be willing to take responsibility for the facilities and equipment used and must agree to abide by CCW rules of conduct for facility use, affirm that their beliefs and practices are in harmony with the CPC as stated below and as described below and in any additional instructions by CCW staff.
- 2) The group or person seeking facility use must read and submit a signed "CCW Rental Agreement" form which will include CCW Policies and Guidelines.
